

Portland AIS literature order/pick up protocol.

Presented at the 7/16/2020 Service Committee meeting

Portland AIS will be taking literature orders for curbside pick-up, starts Friday, July 31, 2020.

1. All literature orders will be placed on Fridays, by 5 p.m., for pickup the following week, on Tuesday or Thursday, at a specified time between 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. **Please specify a 30 minutes arrival window.**
2. Literature orders can be phoned in to the AIS office, 503-292-1333 or 503-297-3551, or (preferred) emailed to the AIS, ais@al-anonportlandoregon.org

On the email subject line, please put "literature order" for easy identification.

All orders will include; the caller's list of requested literature, their, name, **phone number**, and to identify if this is a purchase for an individual or the group name.

3. All orders must "specify" pick up date and time. Available windows for curbside pickups will be on Tuesday and Thursday of the following week, between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.
4. Literature orders will be confirmed on the following Monday; pick up date, time, order cost, and pick up location.
5. Literature pickups: At the agreed-upon date and time, please park your vehicle at the northwest corner of the Skyline Building, 1750 Southwest Skyline Boulevard, just outside our office.
6. Call the office and let them know you are there for your literature pick up.
7. Your payment should be a check or cash for the "exact amount" of your order. Please put phone # and name on checks. Please put it into an envelope with your name or the group's name on the outside of the envelope.
8. One of our co-managers will be masked, and will bring your order out in a bag, and exchange it for your payment. We request you are masked for this exchange. We will observe social distancing during this brief interaction.
